## PREPARE

- Get waterproof bins to store any photos, videos, memorabilia for the move
- Have Sharpie Markers, paper and/or tape to label the boxes with Photos, Videos, Slides, Memories, etc.
- Designate an area where all the bins of photos will be stored until moving day
